Smoking Pollution Control Ordinance

July 15, 2010 – Oakland, California - Oakland Coliseum Joint Venture, managers of the Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum and Oracle Arena, are charged with the management and day-to-day operations at the facilities.

Last year the Oakland City Council passed an ordinance regarding health concerns found from pollution of tobacco smoke.

The Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum and Oracle Arena will now become “Smoke Free” under O.M.C. 8.30.040, “All facilities owned by the City shall be subject to provisions of this chapter.”

The Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum and Oracle Arena will now become “Smoke Free” based on the subject ordinance, effective August 1, 2010. As a result of this ordinance, designated smoking areas will no longer exist in or near the Stadium or Arena.
