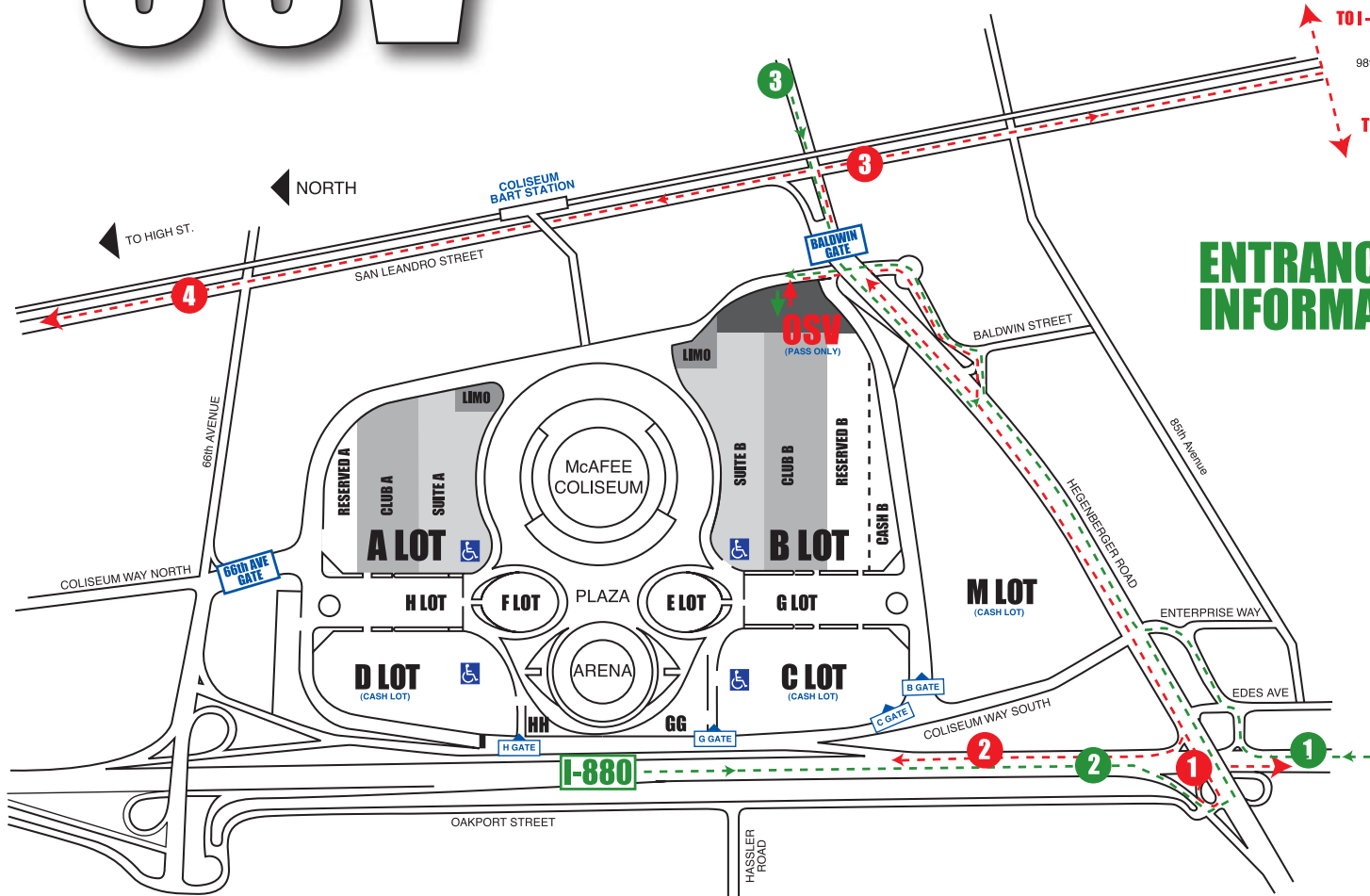

- Left onto Edes Ave.
- Cont. straight onto Coliseum Way
- Right into OSV LOT (Pass Only)

2 SOUTHBOUND I-880

ENTRANCE FROM SOUTHBOUND I-880

- Hegenberger Rd. Exit from I-880
- Left onto Hegenberger Rd.
- Left onto Coliseum Way
- Right into OSV LOT (Pass Only)

3 WESTBOUND HEGENBERGER RD.

ENTRANCE FROM HEGENBERGER RD.

- West on Hegenberger Rd.
- Left onto Baldwin St. Access
- Right onto Coliseum Way
- Right into OSV LOT (Pass Only)

EXIT INFORMATION

1 SOUTHBOUND I-880 EXIT

- Exit via Baldwin St. Access
- Left onto Hegenberger Rd.
- Right on-ramp to I-880 South

2 NORTHBOUND I-880 EXIT

- Exit via Baldwin St. Access
- Left onto Hegenberger Rd.
- Right on-ramp to I-880 North

3 I-580 / I-880 ALT. EXIT 3 98TH. AVE ALT. EXIT SOUTH VIA SAN LEANDRO ST.

- Exit via Baldwin St. Access
- Right onto Hegenberger Rd.
- San Leandro St. Exit from Hegenberger Rd.
- Right onto San Leandro St.
- To I-580: Left onto 98th Ave.
- To I-880: Right onto 98th Ave.

4 I-580 / I-880 ALT. EXIT 4 HIGH STREET ALT. EXIT NORTH VIA SAN LEANDRO ST.

- Exit via Baldwin St. Access
- Right onto Hegenberger Rd.
- San Leandro St. Exit from Hegenberger Rd.
- Left onto San Leandro St.
- To I-580: Right onto High St.
- To I-880: Left onto High St.

COLISEUM PARKING LOT GUIDE

We want all fans to enjoy the action and excitement of Raiders football. Beginning with the 2008 season, McAfee Coliseum has instituted policies in the parking lots and stadium to comply with the Oakland Municipal Code, enhance fans' tailgate experience, and be responsive to fan feedback. Please be aware of these changes as you make tailgate and game day plans. We appreciate your help in making the Coliseum and parking lots an enjoyable environment for all fans, guests, and tailgaters.

- Overnight parking is prohibited.
- Line-up for early arriving vehicles will begin at 5:00 a.m. for all lots and all gates. Please note that for games with kickoff times after 5:00 p.m., line-up will begin at 11:00 a.m.
- By Oakland City Ordinance, all D.J. set-ups, bands, performances, and amplified noise or music are prohibited. This policy will be enforced by law enforcement and violations may result in confiscation of equipment and/or citations.
- Bills larger than \$20.00 will not be accepted.
- Limousine parking is \$75.00 per game. Please contact the Raiders Ticket Office to pre-purchase your limousine parking pass.
- Over-sized vehicles, including RVs, buses, and trailers, must have a pre-purchased pass for the over-sized vehicle parking lot. Please contact the Raider Ticket Office for more information.
- The Oakland Raiders Fan Code of Conduct will be enforced in all parking lots. Behavior prohibited by the Code of Conduct will not be tolerated in the parking lots.

FAN CODE OF CONDUCT

We want all fans to enjoy the action and excitement of Raiders football. We expect all who enter the stadium and surrounding parking lots to adhere to this Code. Failure to follow this Code may result in ejection from the stadium, revocation of ticket privileges, and/or arrest. Although Season Ticket Holders may provide their tickets to others, the account holder of record is responsible for the actions of those using their tickets.

The following actions are prohibited:

- Fighting, taunting, or engaging in any action that may harm, endanger, threaten, or bring discomfort to anyone in the stadium.
- Sitting in a seat other than one's ticketed seat location or refusing to produce one's game ticket upon request by stadium personnel.
- Possession or use of any illegal drugs or irresponsible use of alcohol.
- Loitering in concourses, aisles, tunnels or stairs.
- Smoking anywhere in the stadium, which is prohibited by the Oakland Municipal Code.
- Use of foul, abusive, or obscene language or gestures.
- Damage, destruction, vandalism, or theft of any property.
- Failure to follow the directions of law enforcement, security, ushers, ticket takers, or any other stadium personnel.
- Unauthorized use of disabled seating platforms or any seating designed for persons with a disability.
- Engaging in any action that causes a disruption, creates an unsafe environment, interferes with the game, or hinders the enjoyment of the game for others.
- Mistreatment of visiting team fans, including verbal abuse, harassment, profanity, confrontations, intimidation, or threatening behavior.
- Refusal to remove or turn inside-out clothing deemed offensive or obscene upon request by stadium personnel.
- Possession of any item listed on the McAfee Coliseum Prohibited Items List.
